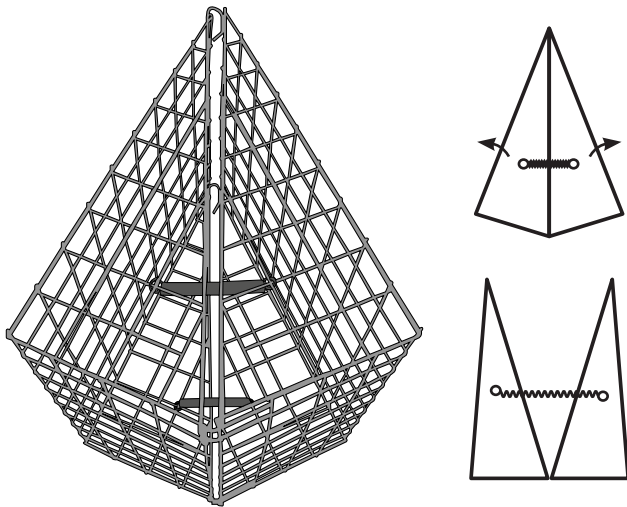
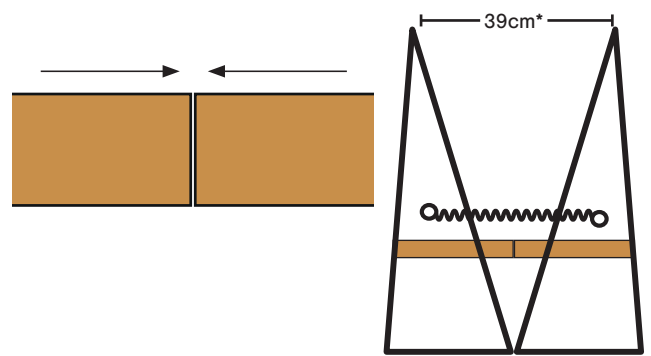


# Elgeeco New Larsen

## Assembly Instructions



**1** To set the trap, pull apart at each side, making sure not to over stretch the springs



**2**

Place a split perch in the centre of the trap. The perch should be a rectangular or circular piece of wood cut squarely in the centre of the perch. The tension from the sides will keep the perch in place.

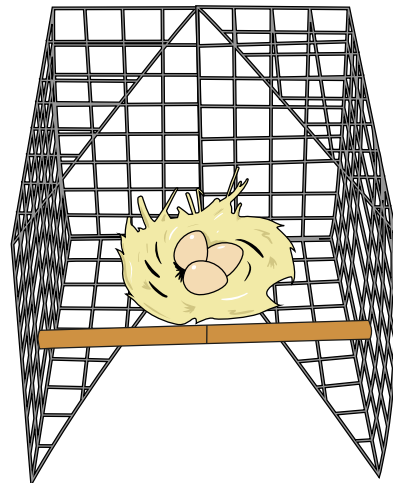
\* In Scotland "When open (set) the minimum distance between any two corners of the trap must be 39 cm."

**3**

The Larsen is now ready to use, though it is recommended to add a fake nest to attract Magpies or crows. If you would like to catch woodpigeons try adding bread or grain\* on a wooden board.

When a bird lands on the perch the perch will collapse and the trap will fold in on itself

\*In Scotland "Eggs or bread are the only permitted baits for use with Larsen mate and Larsen pod traps." and every trap must have a unique ID tag attached.



**4**

The strength of the trap can be increased by moving the springs further apart on the trap.

Opening the trap too wide can damage the springs



**Always observe strict hygiene during and after handling the trap.**
